What is **parcs**?

The **performing artist royalty collection service (parcs)** is a specialized service for recording artists and their estates, through which we collect and distribute royalty revenue based on the public performance of recorded music in the United States and internationally.

What royalties do you collect?

Primarily, **parcs** collects royalties that are owing to recording artists when their recordings are used by webcasters, cable broadcasters, satellite radio companies and others. In the United States these new royalties have become available because of recent changes in Federal Copyright Law.

Why should I use **parcs** to collect my money?
